Requirements: Candidates for a Career and Technical Education Scholarship, will complete a comprehensive application that will confirm their eligibility qualifications, demonstrates the need for financial assistance and highlights the candidate's qualifications, discusses his or her educational and career goals in light of Rotary's motto of "Service Above Self" and describes why he or she should receive this scholarship. The Career and Technical Education Scholarship committee of the Rotary Club of Ellicottville may interview candidates.

- Letters of recommendation from two teachers at your high school.
- Evidence demonstrating financial need.
